Lake Arvesta Field Trip Expectations

All students attending this trip will be expected to abide by the guidelines listed below. We must be confident that all students will be safe on the trip.

- Students are expected to follow Cityside Middle School's Code of Conduct/Rules
 throughout the year--as well as on the trip itself. If students' behavior or
 performance is inappropriate (as deemed by administration), they may forfeit the
 trip.
- Students who have lost the privilege of the field trip will remain at school with work to complete independently.
- Students are **not** allowed to bring a cell phone on the trip. This is the ZPS policy for middle school students at school that will be enforced (along with all other rules) on the trip. More importantly, it allows everyone to "unplug" for a while, which really is an amazing part of this trip's experience. Students may use a chaperone's phone to call home if needed.
- Students will follow the dress code from the Cityside handbook. This includes appropriate, modest swimwear. Students will wear casual attire (e.g. t-shirt and shorts) when not in the water.
- Students may bring one tote bag or backpack with them for the day. This must be kept in the seat with them on the bus while traveling.
 - o This is a "rain or shine" event, so plan accordingly.
 - o Eating/Drinking is not allowed on the school buses.
- Students who typically have (and take) medicine stored at the school office will see Mrs. Klein for those as needed throughout the day.
- Students must indicate whether they will bring their own lunch from home or receive a lunch from the school cafeteria. School lunch options will be provided closer to the day of the field trip.
